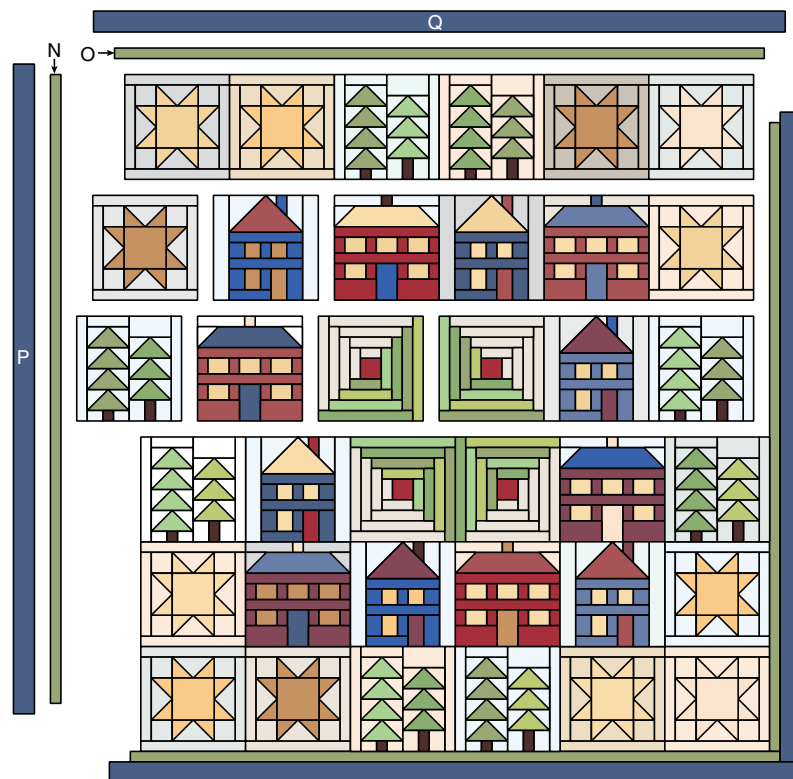
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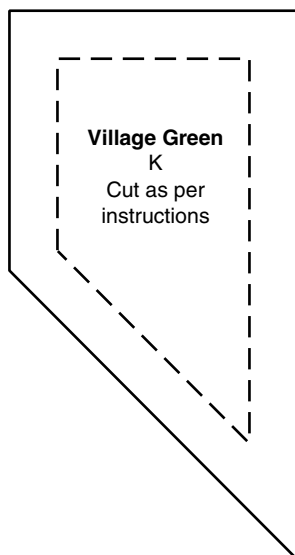
COMPLETING THE QUILT

1. Referring to the Assembly Diagram, arrange the blocks into six rows as shown. Sew the blocks into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt center; press.
2. Sew the N border strips to opposite sides of the quilt center and the O border strips to the top and bottom; press.
3. Sew the P border strips to opposite sides and Q border strips to the top and bottom and press to complete the quilt top.
4. Layer, quilt as desired and bind referring to Quilting Basics. **QW**

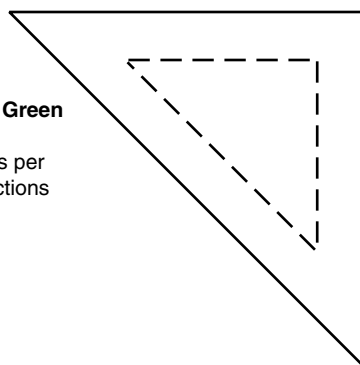


Village Green

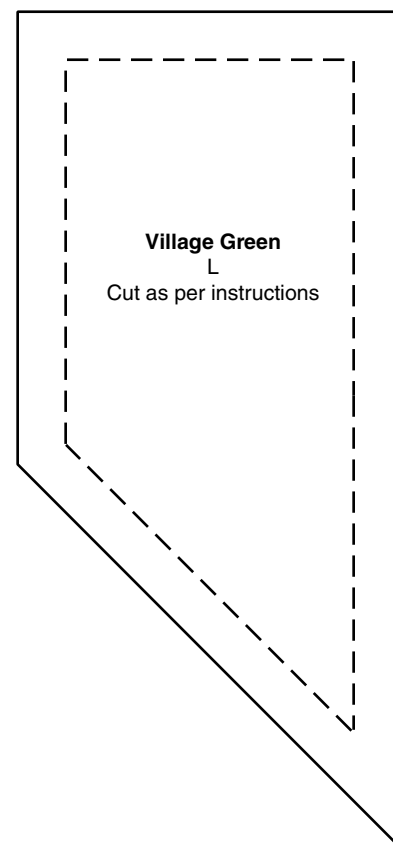

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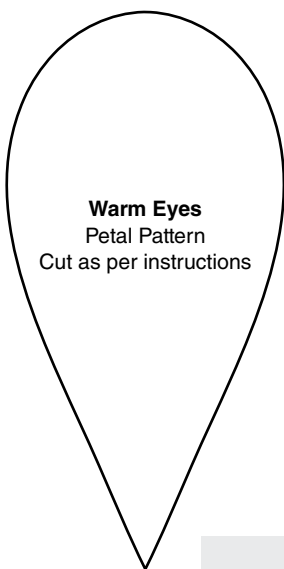
5. Stitch three Medium Sashing blocks, two Light Sashing blocks and two J triangles together, as shown in Figure 6, to make a center row.

6. Join two each corner units and Row 1 and center row diagonally referring to Assembly Diagram to complete pieced quilt center.

COMPLETING THE QUILT

1. Stitch $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" L/M Group 2 strips together on short ends to make one long strip; press seams in one direction. Cut L/M strip into two each $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47" L and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ " M strips for first border.

When printing pattern pieces check to make sure your print settings are set to print at 100 percent and page scaling displays "None."

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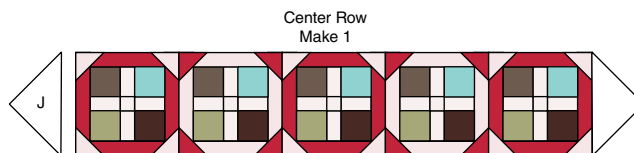

2. Stitch L to top and bottom of quilt center and M to both sides referring to Assembly Diagram.

3. Stitch 2" x 22" N/O Group 3 strips together on short ends to make one long strip; press seams in one direction. Cut N/O strip into two each 2" x 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ " N and 2" x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " O strips for first border.

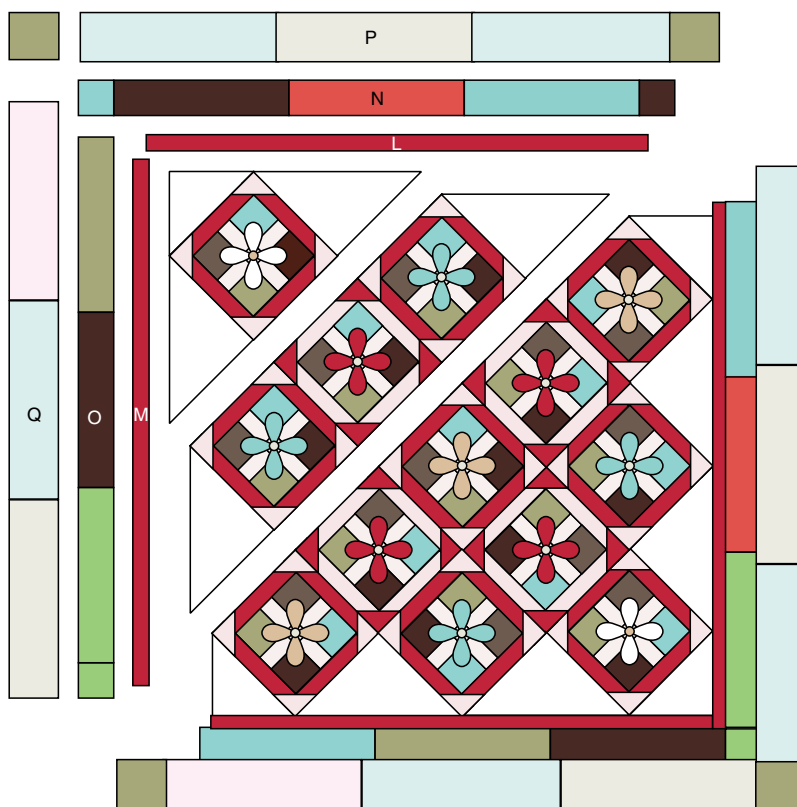
4. Stitch N to top and bottom of quilt center and O to both sides referring to Assembly Diagram.

5. Stitch $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" P/Q Group 1 strips together on short ends to

make one long strip; press seams in one direction. Cut P/Q strip into two each $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " P and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Q strips for first border.

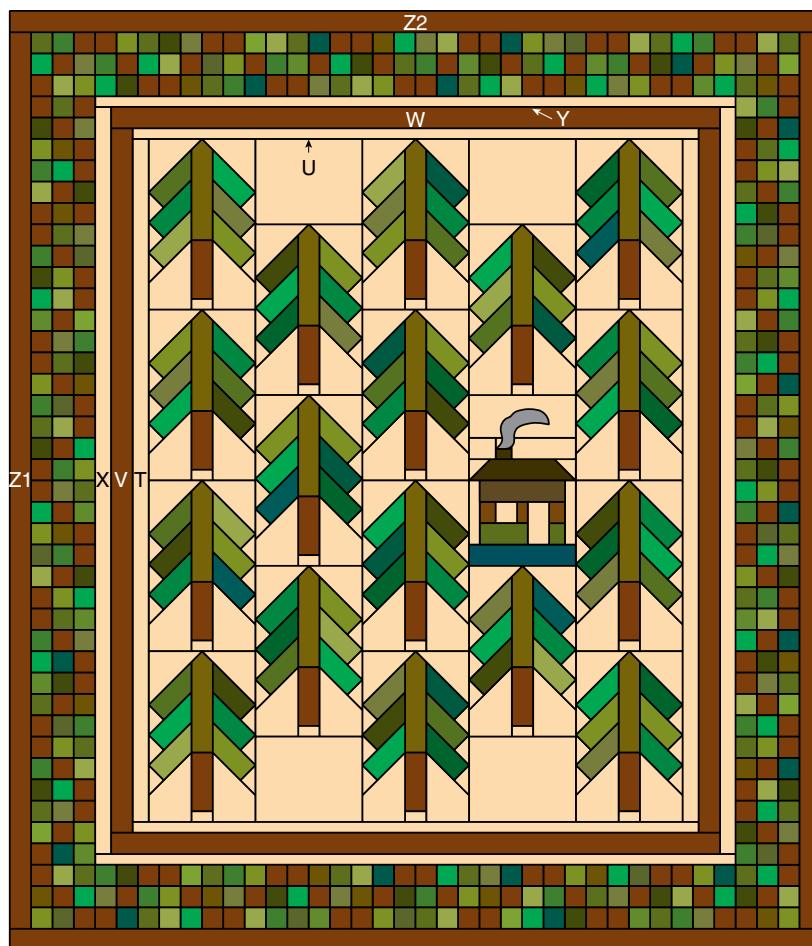
6. Stitch P to top and bottom of quilt center and Q to both sides referring to Assembly Diagram.

7. Layer, quilt as desired and bind. Sew one button to the center of each block. **Note:** The designer cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips from remaining fat quarters for binding. If you prefer a solid binding, you will need to purchase $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of coordinating fabric. **QW**

8. Sew T strips to opposite long sides and U strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press seams toward T and U strips.
9. Repeat step 8 with V and W strips and then X and Y strips, pressing seams toward the V and W strips.
10. Join 12 Nine-Patch blocks, rotating every other block, to make a Nine-Patch strip, again referring to Figure 17; press seams in one direction. Repeat to make a total of four Nine-Patch strips.
11. Sew a Nine-Patch strip to opposite long sides and then to the top and bottom of the pieced center; press seams toward the Nine-Patch strips.
12. Sew a Z1 strip to opposite long sides and the Z2 strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top; press seams toward Z1 and Z2 strips.

Placement Diagram 76" x 88"

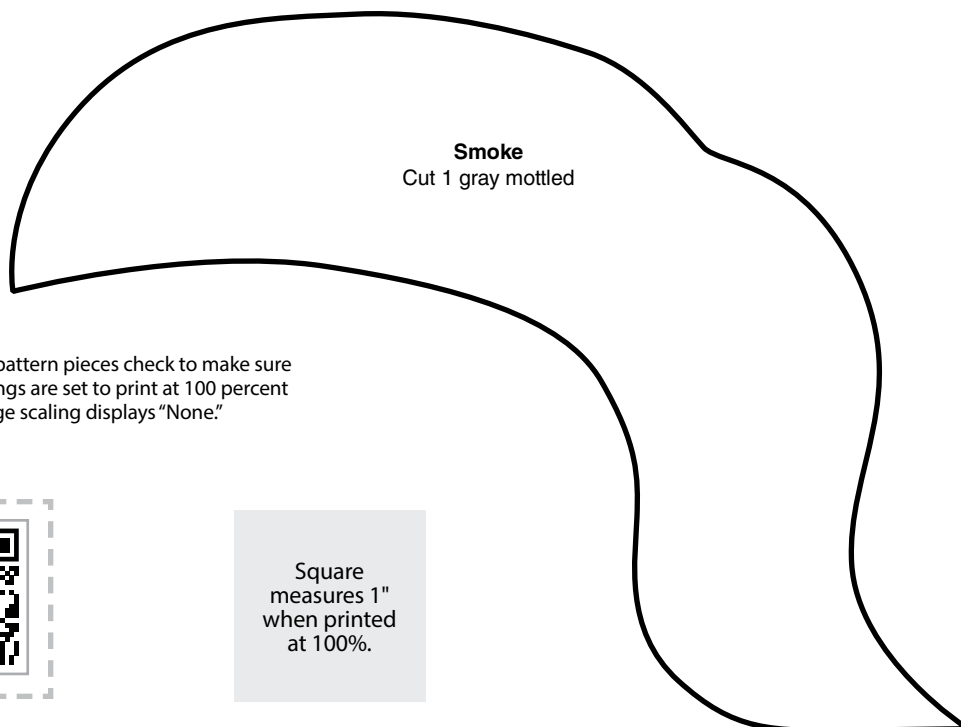

8. Fill the pincushion lining with crushed walnut shells or fiberfill to preferred fullness. A funnel is helpful if using the crushed shells.
9. Hand-sew the edges of the lining together to close.
10. Fold in the seam allowance of the opening on the wool and hand-stitch the folded edges together to close. Decorate your pincushion with a spooky pin or two! **QW**

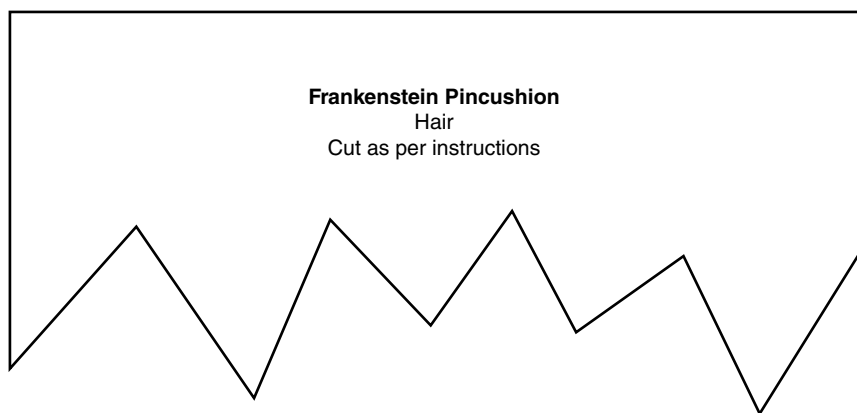
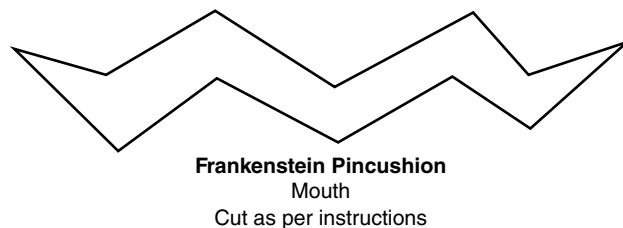
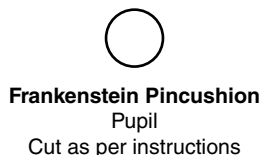
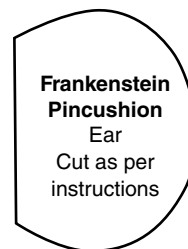
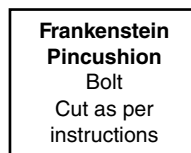
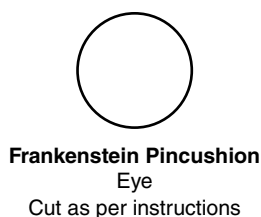


Frankenstein Pincushion

Here's a Tip

To make fun pins to coordinate with your pincushion, glue a small decorative button or charm with a flat back to the top of a flat long quilting pin, using a glue that works with plastic.

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6. To make bow, fold orange strip in half lengthwise with right sides together. Referring to Figure 2, sew the short and long raw edges together, leaving a 2" opening in the middle.

7. Trim the corners and turn right side out, press. Fold in the seam allowance on the opening and slipstitch edges together to close.

8. Tie fabric strip in a bow and tack the knot to the left end of the quilted neck line.

9. Sew green buttons to face for eyes, black button over center of whiskers for nose and spider to one tail of bow.

10. Hand-stitch plastic ring to back of right ear to finish, being careful not to stitch through the front of the pot holder, as shown in Figure 3. **QW**

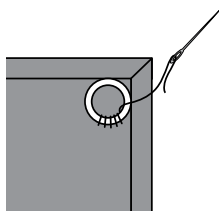


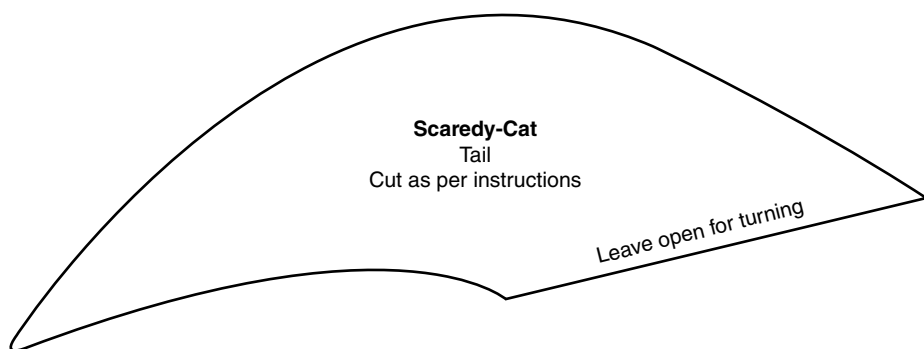

Scaredy-Cat

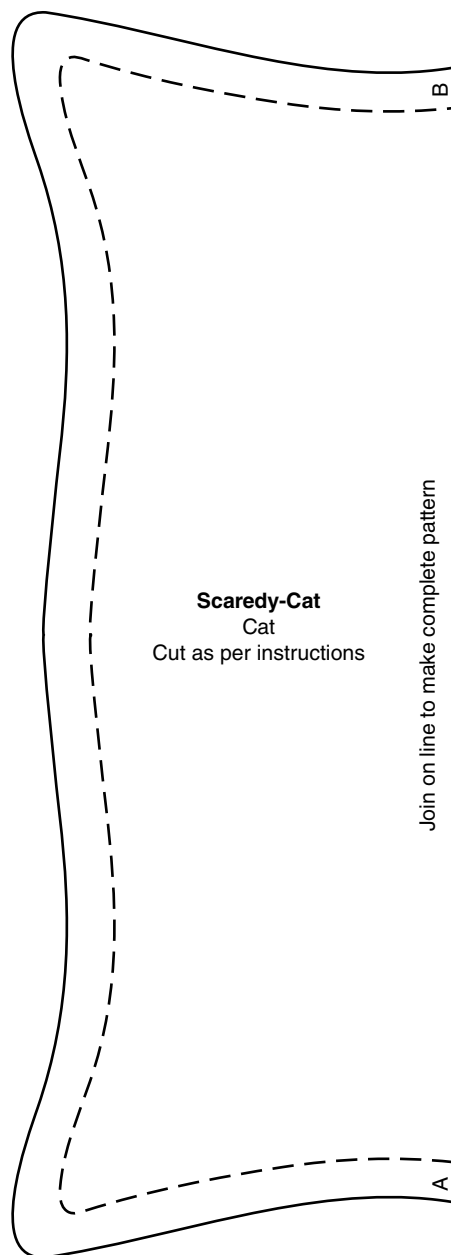
